# **God's Love and Our Call to Love Others as Ourselves.**

## **Thanksgiving for God's Unconditional Love**

Scripture Basis: 1 John 4:9-10

"Father, thank You for demonstrating Your perfect love through the sacrifice of Your Son. We praise You for loving us first and making us Your children. Help us to live in the assurance of Your love every day."

## **Prayer for the Ability to Love as God Loves**

Scripture Basis: 1 John 4:7-8

"Lord, fill our hearts with Your love so that we may love others genuinely. Teach us to reflect Your nature, for You are love. Let Your love be evident in our words, actions, and attitudes."

## **Prayer for the Grace to Love Our Neighbors**

Scripture Basis: Mark 12:31

"Lord, help us to love our neighbors as ourselves. Give us compassionate hearts and a willingness to serve others selflessly. Break down any barriers of division, and let Your love flow through us."

## **Prayer for Forgiveness and Reconciliation**

Scripture Basis: 1 Corinthians 13:5

"Father, teach us to keep no record of wrongs but to forgive as You have forgiven us. Bring healing and reconciliation to broken relationships, and let love be the foundation of our interactions."

## **Prayer to Love Our Enemies**

Scripture Basis: Matthew 5:44

"Lord Jesus, strengthen us to love even those who hurt or oppose us. Help us to pray for our enemies and bless those who curse us, following Your example of grace and mercy."

## **Prayer to Share God's Love Boldly**

Scripture Basis: John 13:34-35

"Lord, empower us to demonstrate Your love so the world may know we are Your disciples. Make us vessels of Your love in word and deed, pointing others to the truth of the gospel through our lives."

**These prayer points emphasize receiving, reflecting, and extending God's love to others as commanded in His Word.**

## **Invite the Holy Spirit's Power to Transform Us, Enabling Us to Love as Jesus Loves.**

### **Prayer for the Fruit of the Spirit**

**Scripture:** Galatians 5:22-23 (NIV) – "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control."

**Prayer:** Lord, fill me with Your Spirit so that my life produces the fruit of love. Let my actions, words, and thoughts reflect the love of Christ in every situation.

### **Prayer for a Heart of Compassion**

**Scripture:** Romans 5:5 (NIV) – "And hope does not put us to shame, because God's love has been poured out into our hearts through the Holy Spirit, who has been given to us."

**Prayer:** Holy Spirit, pour God's love into my heart. Help me to see others as Jesus sees them and respond with compassion, kindness, and care.

### **Prayer for Strength to Forgive**

**Scripture:** Colossians 3:13 (NIV) – "Bear with each other and forgive one another if any of you has a grievance against someone. Forgive as the Lord forgave you."

**Prayer:** Father, by the power of the Holy Spirit, enable me to forgive those who hurt me. Give me the grace to love unconditionally, just as Jesus has forgiven and loved me.

### **Prayer for Selfless Service**

**Scripture:** Philippians 2:3-4 (NIV) – "Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves, not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of the others."

**Prayer:** Lord, empower me through the Holy Spirit to love selflessly, putting others before myself. Let humility and service define my love, reflecting the heart of Christ.

### **Prayer for Perfected Love that Casts Out Fear**

**Scripture:** 1 John 4:18 (NIV) – "There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love."

**Prayer:** Holy Spirit, perfect Your love in me so that fear has no place. Help me to love boldly and confidently, trusting in the power of Christ's perfect love.

## **God's Truth That All Are Equal in Christ.**

### **Prayer for Unity in the Body of Christ**

*Scripture Basis: Galatians 3:28*

"Lord, we pray for unity in Your Church. Help us to live as one body, without divisions of race, class, gender, or nationality. Let us reflect Your love and equality to the world around us, showing that in You, we are all one."

### **Prayer Against Partiality and Discrimination**

*Scripture Basis: Acts 10:34-35*

"Father, we thank You for showing no partiality. We repent of any bias or prejudice in our hearts. Help us to see people through Your eyes, embracing all who fear You and do what is right, regardless of their background or status."

### **Prayer for Spiritual Renewal and Christ-centered Identity**

*Scripture Basis: Colossians 3:11*

"Lord Jesus, renew our minds and hearts to find our identity in You alone. Let no earthly distinction define us more than our belonging to You. May we all grow in love and grace, knowing that You are all, and You are in all."

### **Prayer for Equal Access to the Gospel**

*Scripture Basis: Galatians 3:28, Acts 10:34-35*

"Lord, we pray that the message of salvation would reach all people without hindrance or favoritism. Open doors for every tribe, tongue, and nation to hear and receive the gospel. Use us to break down barriers and share Your good news with all."

### **Prayer for Justice and Equality in Society**

*Scripture Basis: Galatians 3:28, Colossians 3:11*

"God of justice, we ask that Your righteousness would prevail in our communities. Inspire leaders to create systems that reflect fairness and equality. Strengthen Your people to stand for justice, showing the world Your heart of love and impartiality."

## **Prayers to Pray This President's Day**

### **Father, grant our President a humble heart (Romans 13:1).**

We pray he would recognize that his authority has been instituted by You, that You are ultimately his ruler and authority, that there's no one like You in heaven or on earth. Humble our President before You, and may the work of his hands be the overflow of a humble heart.

### **May salvation come to his house (Luke 19:9).**

As the Son of Man came to seek and save the lost, be pleased to save the many lost souls who live and labor in the White House! We pray for conviction of sin, repentance by faith, and a grasping hold of Jesus Christ for salvation. We pray for the boldness of Christians whom You've placed there for such a time as this.

### **Grant him wisdom (Psalm 90:12).**

May he recognize that You are from everlasting to everlasting, and how his days are fleeting in comparison. Through a strong sense of his weakness and Your infinitude, power, and strength, give him a heart of wisdom and a mind able to discern what's best for our country.

### **Protect him from foolishness (Deuteronomy 32:6).**

Father, as our nature is to act foolishly and reject wisdom, we ask that You would protect our President from this. Surround him with advisors and counselors who will speak truthfully and soundly. Advance Your wise plans through his cabinet, security council, and staff; guard them from folly, we pray.

### **Equip him to exercise your justice (1 Peter 2:14).**

As you send those in governing authority "to punish those who do evil and to praise those who do good," may he do so according to the standards of Your ways. Only You, God, are perfectly just; but we pray for an extension of Your righteous justice through our President.

### **Help us remember that our true citizenship is in heaven (Philippians 3:20).**

Whether we feel anxious or prideful, worried or at ease, our desire is to root our identity in Jesus Christ and our eternity with Him, not in the United States of America or in our President. Help us set our minds on things above and not neglect such a great salvation we have in Christ!

**Humble us to submit to our governing authorities in any way not directly opposed to your will (Titus 3:1).**

You are our ruler and rescuer, and we rest secure in You. May this security free us to humbly submit to our President and all the authorities operating under him inasmuch as they follow your ways. Give us wisdom to know what this submission looks like as we ultimately submit to You and Your Word.

**Thank you for your common grace and every good gift (Matthew 5:45).**

We know freedom, industry, jobs, healthcare, and a stable economy come at no small cost. Thank You for the men and women who've sacrificed to serve our President and country by protecting and leading us. Thank You for making Your "sun rise on the evil and on the good, and [for sending] rain on the just and on the unjust." You show Your goodness and kindness through these common, good gifts.

**Show us how we can contribute, serve, speak, and act in a way that exalts Christ (Colossians 3:17).**

We want to do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to You, Father, through Him. We want to use our gifts and opportunities to better our country and ultimately honor Jesus' name. May Your Church be the hands and feet of Christ to our nation.

**May our confidence be in Your Son, not in our country or President (Philippians 3:3).**

Our greatest delight, deepest satisfaction, and highest reward is to know Christ and draw near to You, Father, through Him and by Your Spirit. May we count everything as loss—a balanced budget, a thriving economy, peace, unity, and freedom—in order that we may gain Christ and be found in him. We want Jesus.
