# Father Replace the Negative Soundtracks In My Mind With Your Truth

**2 Corinthians 10:5** – "We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ."

**Prayer Point:** Lord, help me capture every negative thought and make it obedient to Your truth. Replace lies with Your wisdom and peace.

**Philippians 4:8** – "Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things."

**Prayer Point:** Father, renew my mind to focus on what is true, noble, and pure. Shift my thoughts to align with Your goodness and love.

**Romans 12:2** – "Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will."

**Prayer Point:** Lord, transform my mind and break worldly patterns of negativity. Help me to discern Your perfect will with clarity and faith.

**Isaiah 26:3** – "You will keep in perfect peace those whose minds are steadfast, because they trust in you."

**Prayer Point:** God, anchor my mind in Your truth so that I may experience Your perfect peace. Help me trust You completely, even in challenging moments.

**2 Timothy 1:7** – "For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind."

**Prayer Point:** Heavenly Father, replace my fears and doubts with Your power, love, and a sound mind. Let Your truth silence every negative voice.

**Jeremiah 31:3** – "The Lord appeared to us in the past, saying: 'I have loved you with an everlasting love; I have drawn you with unfailing kindness.'"

**Prayer Point:** Lord, help me replace thoughts of rejection and unworthiness with the truth of Your everlasting love and unfailing kindness.

**Psalm 23:1-6** – "The Lord is my shepherd; I shall not want... Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever."

**Prayer Point:** Father, silence thoughts of lack and fear by reminding me that You are my Shepherd, guiding me with goodness and mercy every day.

**2 Corinthians 12:9** – "But he said to me, 'My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness.""

**Prayer Point:** Jesus, replace my feelings of inadequacy with the truth of Your sufficient grace. Help me find strength in my weaknesses through Your power.

**Isaiah 41:10** – "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand."

**Prayer Point:** Lord, when fear and discouragement arise, remind me that You are with me, strengthening and upholding me with Your righteous hand.

**Ephesians 2:10** – "For we are God's handiwork, created in Christ Jesus to do good works, which God prepared in advance for us to do."

**Prayer Point:** Heavenly Father, help me reject thoughts of insignificance by embracing the truth that I am Your masterpiece, created with purpose and destiny.

# Holy Spirit Equip Me.

Galatians 5:22-23 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control. Against such things there is no law."

#### **Prayer Point:**

Holy Spirit, cultivate Your fruit in me. Let love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control grow in my life. Help me to reflect Your character in every interaction and situation.

1 Corinthians 12:4-7 "There are different kinds of gifts, but the same Spirit distributes them. There are different kinds of service, but the same Lord. There are different kinds of working, but in all of them and in everyone it is the same God at work. Now to each one the manifestation of the Spirit is given for the common good."

#### **Prayer Point:**

Spirit of God, reveal the gifts You have placed within me. Help me to understand and use them to serve others and glorify You. Let me operate in unity with the body of Christ, contributing to the common good.

Romans 12:6-8 "We have different gifts, according to the grace given to each of us. If your gift is prophesying, then prophesy in accordance with your faith; if it is serving, then serve; if it is teaching, then teach; if it is to encourage, then give encouragement; if it is giving, then give generously; if it is to lead, do it diligently; if it is to show mercy, do it cheerfully."

#### **Prayer Point:**

Lord, grant me the grace to serve according to the gifts You've given me. Whether it's prophesying, teaching, encouraging, giving, leading, or showing mercy, may I do it diligently and cheerfully, reflecting Your love and purpose.

These prayer points, rooted in **Matthew 6:9-13**, provide a structured and heartfelt approach to prayer. They encourage worship, submission, dependence, forgiveness, protection, and praise – aligning hearts with God's will.

# 1. Worship and Reverence

**Verse:** "Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name." (Matthew 6:9)

- Acknowledge God's holiness and greatness.
- Pray for a heart of worship that honors God's name in all you do.
- Ask for a deeper understanding of God as a loving Father.

**Prayer Point:** "Lord, I exalt Your holy name. Teach me to honor and glorify You daily. Help me understand the depth of Your love as my Heavenly Father."

Verse: "Your kingdom come. Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:10)

**Prayer Point:** "Father, let Your kingdom come in my life, community, and nation. Align my heart with Your will and help me live in obedience to Your purpose."

# 3. Provision and Dependence on God

Verse: "Give us this day our daily bread." (Matthew 6:11)

- Acknowledge God as the source of all needs.
- Pray for daily provision physical, emotional, and spiritual.
- Cultivate contentment and gratitude for God's sustenance.

**Prayer Point:** "Lord, I trust You to provide for my needs today. Teach me to rely on You and be content with what You give."

### 4. Forgiveness and Mercy

**Verse:** "And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors." (Matthew 6:12)

- Confess sins and seek God's forgiveness.

**Prayer Point:** "Lord, guard my heart and mind from temptation. Protect me from evil and guide me on the path of righteousness."

## 6. Praise and Acknowledgment of God's Sovereignty

Verse: "For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen."

- Declare God's authority and power over all things.
- Praise Him for His eternal rule and glory.
- Affirm trust in God's sovereignty and goodness.

**Prayer Point:** "All glory and honor belong to You, O God. I trust in Your power and acknowledge Your eternal reign."
